## MENTAL HEALTH CAPACITY BUILDING PROJECT

Hi my name is Jillian Coulas and I am Delia's new Youth Wellness Worker of the Mental Health Capacity Building Expansion Project for Children and Families. This project is one of 39 Mental Health Capacity Building in School Initiative projects for Alberta. This project is an integrated multidisciplinary team approach providing promotion, prevention and early intervention addiction and mental health services to children and their families in Hanna, Delia and Morrin schools. This initiative is funded through Alberta Health and Wellness and led by Alberta Health Services-Addiction and Mental Health in partnership with Alberta Education along with other partners and community agencies.

Recently I have moved to Hanna from Calgary, but originally grew up around Spruce Grove Alberta. Calgary became home when I moved there five years



ago to attend the Community Rehabilitation and Disability Studies program at the University of Calgary, and later went on to work with local organizations supporting people with disabilities within the community and facilitating programs for newcomer youth. I am now looking forward to settling away from the city and getting to know the community of Delia. I am also very excited to offer in school, afterschool, Easter and summer break programming along with community events and information sessions for the children, youth, families and the community.
