BYLAW REMINDERS

WEEDS AND THE FAILURE TO CUT GRASS IS IN CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAW 531.

A nuisance is any condition on or around a Property that is untidy, unsightly, offensive, dangerous to health or which interferes with the use and enjoyment of other Property, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, includes:

- i) The failure to cut grass or weeds;
- ii) The growth of trees or shrubs in such a manner that they interfere with civic works or any public utility or endanger visibility to street signage or sidewalk roadway clearance

Boulevard maintenance is also the responsibility of the property owner

Any yard improvements such as sheds, fences & decks may need a development permit. Please be sure to check with the Village Office before commencing additions or renovations.
