## NEW TRAFFIC BYLAW

Council has given a new Traffic Bylaw first and second reading at the June 29<sup>th</sup> Council meeting. The Bylaw states that the speed limit within the Village limits will be changed to **30km/h**. A **new 4 Way Stop** will be placed at 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue & 1<sup>st</sup> Street West to slow the traffic through the school zone. A **new Stop sign** will also be placed Southbound at the Y intersection of Main Street. This Bylaw also includes the parking regulations and truck routes. Any concerns can be brought forward to Council at the August regular meeting prior to third reading. Once third reading has been completed, the new signs will be installed.
